LIEUTENANT COLONEL GREGORY L. DUTKA

Lieutenant Colonel Gregory L. Dutka is the Deputy Commandant and Army Element of the Defense Language Institute English Language Center, Lackland Air Force Base, San Antonio, Texas.

LTC Dutka was born in Bedford, Ohio. He was commissioned as a second lieutenant in 1994 at the University of Pittsburgh, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, where he earned his Bachelor of Arts degree in political science. LTC Dutka has a master's in business and organizational security from Webster University. His military education includes the Military Intelligence Officer Basic Course, the Military Intelligence Captains Career Course, the U.S. Army Counterintelligence Officer's Course, Combined Arms Services Staff School and Command and General Staff College.



LTC Dutka first served as the Assistant S2, 1st Battalion, 67th Armor Regiment, Ground Surveillance Radar Platoon Leader, A Company, 104th Military Intelligence Battalion, and Executive Officer, A Company, 104th MI Battalion at Ft Hood, Texas. Following the MICCC, he was assigned to the 501st MI Brigade, where he served as the Deputy Operations Officer. LTC Dutka subsequently served as both the Battalion S4, 524th MI Battalion, and Company Commander, A Company, 524th MI Battalion, Seoul, Republic of Korea.

He returned to the U.S. in 2001 and was assigned to 304th MI Battalion, 111th MI, where he served as the Tactics Committee Chief and a Training Advise Counsel officer for the MI Officer's Basic Course, OIC of the Joint Intelligence-Combat Training Center, Company Commander, Headquarters Company, 111th MI Brigade, and Executive Officer, 309th MI Battalion at Ft Huachuca, Arizona. Following CGSC, he was assigned to Fort Sam Houston, where he served as the Battalion Operations Officer, 14th MI Battalion (Interrogation). Following a deployment to Iraq, LTC Dutka was assigned to the United States Army South, to serve as the Deployable Intelligence Support Element Chief. He assumed the DLIELC Deputy Commandant position September 1, 2011.

LTC Dutka's deployment history includes Chief, Joint Document Exploitation Center in support of the Presidentially mandated Iraq Survey Group, Forward Operating Base Freedom, Mosul, Iraq (2004-2005); Joint Operations Officer, Joint Interrogation and Debriefing Center, Combined Joint Task Force – 134, Camp Cropper, Baghdad, Iraq (2009-2010).

His military decorations include the Bronze Star Medal, Meritorious Service Medal (2 OLC), Joint Service Commendation Medal, Army Commendation Medal (1 OLC), Army Achievement Medal, Iraq Campaign Medal, and the Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal.

LTC Dutka is married to Major Susan M. Galich of Puyallup, Washington. MAJ Galich is currently attending the National Defense Intelligence College as a master's of science in Strategic Intelligence candidate.
