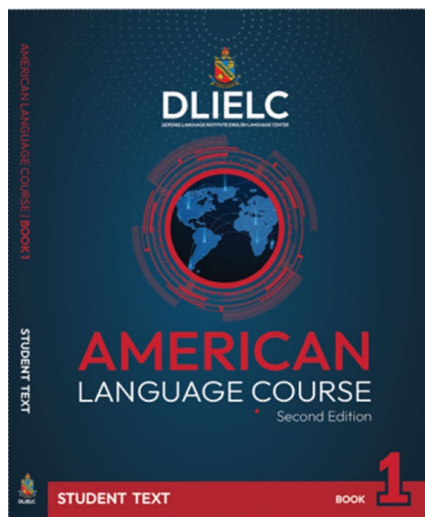


American Language Course Second Edition, Major Revision
